**Information for  
Boaters**





The docks at Newcastle Island can get VERY busy during the summer season.

Please use this information pamphlet as a tool to keep yourself and everyone else using the public docks safe and happy.

### Dock Etiquette:

- Move to the front of the dock to allow access for other boaters.
- No rafting boats together – Single tie-ups only!
- Do not set up tables and chairs on docks as it restricts public access and passage.
- No barbeques or portable fire places on the docks. All cooking must be done in the day-use area or on your boat.
- Ensure all food and anything with scent and personal belongings are locked away to keep raccoons and otters off your vessel.
- Do not discharge bilge/grey water in the park.
- Be mindful of the people around you. Keep voices and music to reasonable and respectful levels.
- Park fees for tie up only; does not allow for exclusive use of docks.

### Park Regulations that must be followed:

NO open alcohol on docks or in day-use areas.

NO smoking on docks or in day-use areas.

Pets MUST be kept on leash AT ALL TIMES!

Quiet time is between 11pm – 7am.

Absolutely “NO SWIMMING/ DIVING” off or around the docks.

Maximum stay is 14 days.

No removal of park resources.

All persons, when requested by a Park Ranger, must produce identification. Park Rangers are peace officers under various pieces of legislation. Failure to produce ID to a park officer is a ticket-able offense.
