## Strathcona Trail Condition Report:

Monitoring of trails and providing condition reports have now ceased and will resume again in the Spring 2020 (approximately mid-May).

Snow has arrived in the alpine and visitors are reminded to use extreme caution in the park at this time of year. Conditions can change fast and trails/paths/footprints can disappear with falling snow. Always try to travel with someone else with at least one person experienced and knowledgeable of the area. Boardwalks, where they are not covered by snow, will be slippery. In early and late winter conditions, snowy areas can be interspersed with extremely wet areas.

## Winter Parking Restrictions:

Paradise Meadows Parking Restrictions are now in effect for all park visitors wishing to park vehicles overnight or for multiple days. Visitors must follow the process on the link entitled "Paradise Meadows Parking Restrictions for the Winter Season" on the Strathcona Provincial Park website or risk the potential of having their vehicle towed away at the owner's expense.

## Reminders:

The use of snowmobiles is **prohibited in all areas** of Strathcona Park. The public is encouraged to observe, record (snowmobile registration and/or vehicle licence plates) and report all infractions to BC Parks, Strathcona Area Supervisor (250-337-2405).

Fires are not permitted anywhere or at any time (all seasons) within Strathcona Park except in authorized and provided BC Parks steel fire rings. This regulation is in effect at all times of the year. No open fires are allowed in any backcountry areas.
