Data is only recorded in certain parks and protected areas due to limited resources; there may be visitation in other parks that may not be reflected in the data. Therefore, provincial attendance figures should be regarded as estimates only.

Camping fees are collected through Discover Camping reservation service (DC) or in park by the Park Operator (PO); Day Use revenues include fees that are collected for hotsprings use, group site day use, and picnic site day use facilities; Boating Revenue includes fees for dock and bouy mooring, marine camping, and annual marine park passes.

²There were camping fee increases of \$2-5 per site in 2015 and 2016, contributing to the increased camping revenue. All parks met the new camping rates by March 15th, 2016.

³Maquinna Hotsprings Revenue not included in the line "Day Use Fees" above.

⁴Park Use Permit Fees fluctuate year to year based on a variety of factors, including the number of commercial recreation or film permits issued per year, the length of individual permits, and permit payments falling across multiple fiscal years. There was a film permit fee increase in January, 2017.

⁵Silver Star Park also generated \$230,577 in revenue for Nordic skiing trail fees in 2016/17; however, this revenue is retained by the non-profit operator, and any money that exceeds the operating costs to run the Nordic facilities is reinvested into the park's infrastructure. As such, park use permit fees for this particular operator are waived. Ski hill revenues fluctuate year to year based on a variety of factors, including the payment date with respect to fiscal year and the quality and length of the ski season.

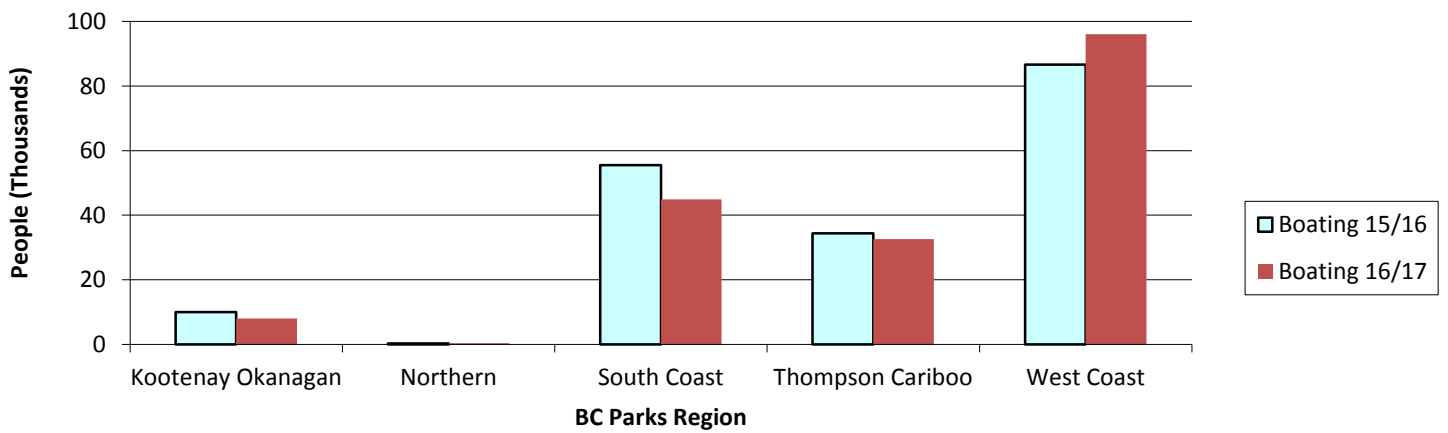

Park Attendance - Boating



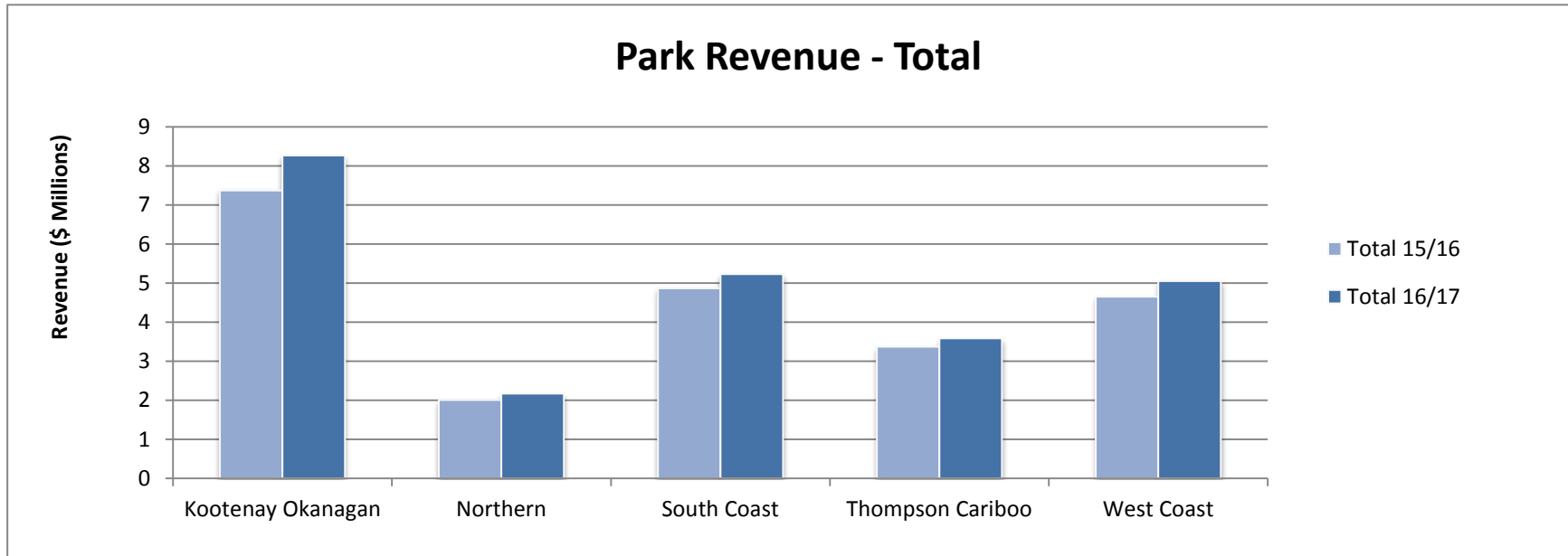

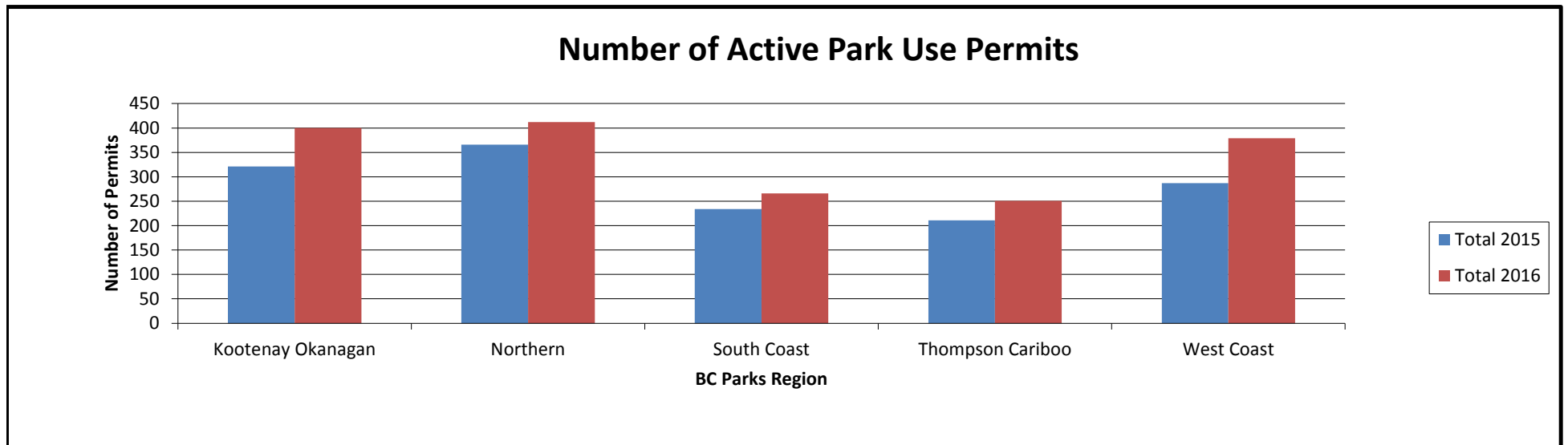

"Land Use/Occupancy" includes structures, utilities, roads, etc. "Trapline" includes Trapline and Trapline LRMP (Land Resource Management Plan) - parks that were identified through a land use planning process, and that pre-existing uses such as trapping were recognized as uses that would continue after park designation. Any park established as a result of land use plan direction will go on the Trapline LRMP template, not the regular Trapline template. "Other" includes Bundled Operations, Non bundled, Tatshenshini River Rafting (Private). Numbers exclude operations permits for Park Facility Operators. Some permits span across multiple regions; in these cases, the permit is attributed to the lead region only. Land Use/Occupancy and Research Permits include BC Hydro's permits.
